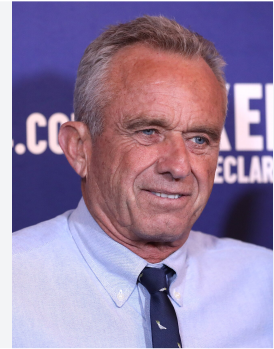
Donald Trump
