Paraphrasing

Paraphrasing helps you express someone else's idea in your own words.

Paraphrasing helps you understand and communicate ideas effectively while avoiding plagiarism.

Keep in mind

- Read the original text carefully to make sure you identify and understand its main ideas, key points and concepts.
- Replace words and phrases with synonyms wherever possible.
- Rearrange the order of words within sentences to create new ones.
- Remember that some words (like names, dates, or titles) cannot be changed

Which of the following is the best paraphrase of the sentence: 'The grass is always greener on the other side of the fence'?

- People tend to desire what they don't have
 The lawn is more vibrant on the opposite side of the barrier

Which of the following is the best paraphrase of the sentence: 'You can't have your cake and eat it too'?

- It's not possible to keep your dessert and also consume it
 You cannot simultaneously retain and consume something

Which of the following is the best paraphrase of the sentence: 'When in Rome, do as the Romans do'?

- While in Rome, behave like the Roman inhabitants
 Adapt to the customs of the places you visit

Which of the following is the best paraphrase of the sentence: 'A stitch in time saves nine'?

- A single stitch made promptly prevents the need for nine later
- Taking timely action can prevent further problems

Which of the following is the best paraphrase of the sentence: 'Beggars can't be choosers'?

- Those in need can't afford to be selective
- People who beg are unable to make choices

Which of the following is the best paraphrase of the sentence: 'Curiosity killed the cat'?

- Inquisitiveness can lead to dangerous situations
- A cat's nosiness can be fatal
