Salvage	The rescue of a ship or its cargo from peril at sea	Recover	Abandon
Flotsam	Wreckage of a ship or its cargo found floating on the sea	Debris	Treasure
Jetty	A landing stage or small pier at which boats can dock or be moored	Pier	Open sea
Maritime	Connected with the sea, especially in relation to seafaring commercial or military activity	Nautical	Landlocked
Provisions	Supplies of food, drink, or equipment, especially for a journey	Rations	Deprivation
Seafarer	A person who regularly travels by sea	Mariner	Landlubber
