Baroque Music

Baroque music is a type of music that was made a long time ago, from about 1600 to 1750. This time is known as the Baroque period. **Baroque** music is special because it has lots of fancy decorations and emotions. Some famous composers from this time are **Johann Sebastian Bach**, **George Frideric Handel**, and **Antonio Vivaldi**.
